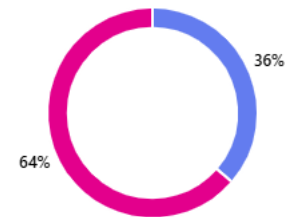

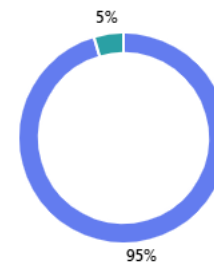

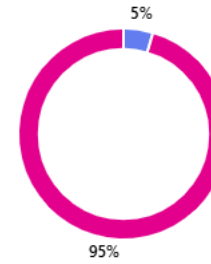

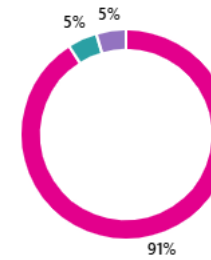

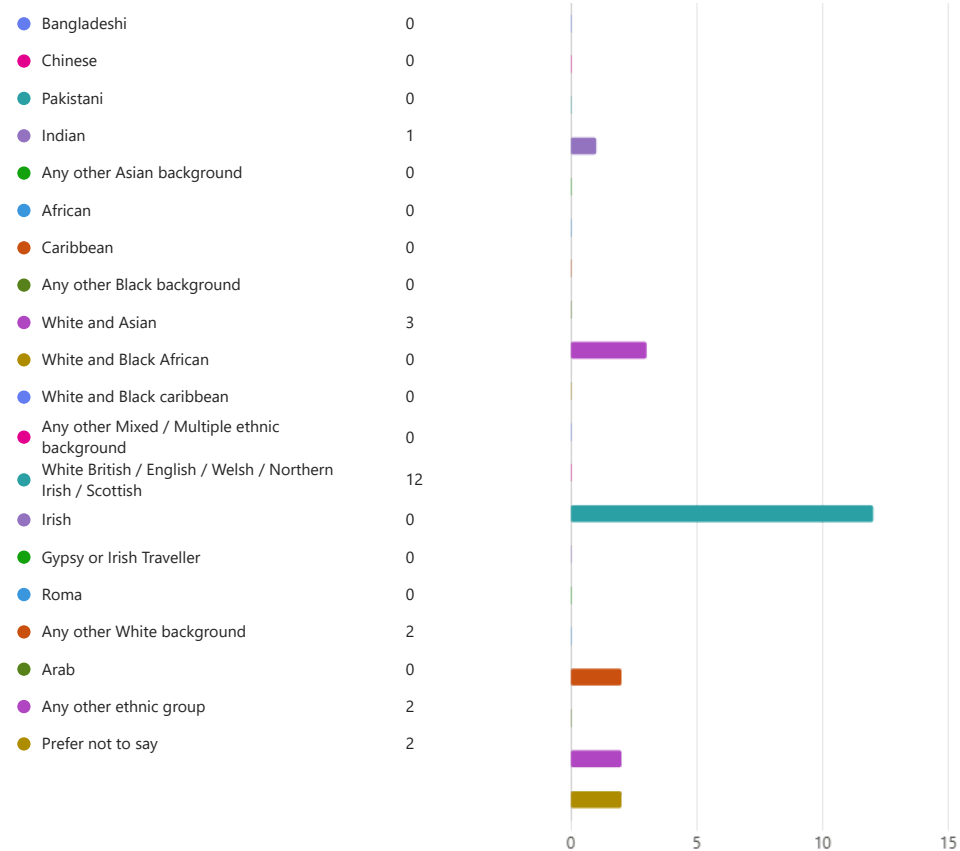


6. Are your day-to-day activities limited by your disability or condition?

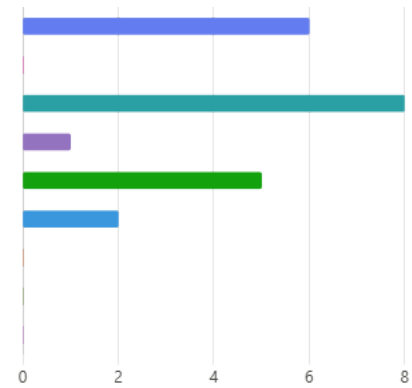

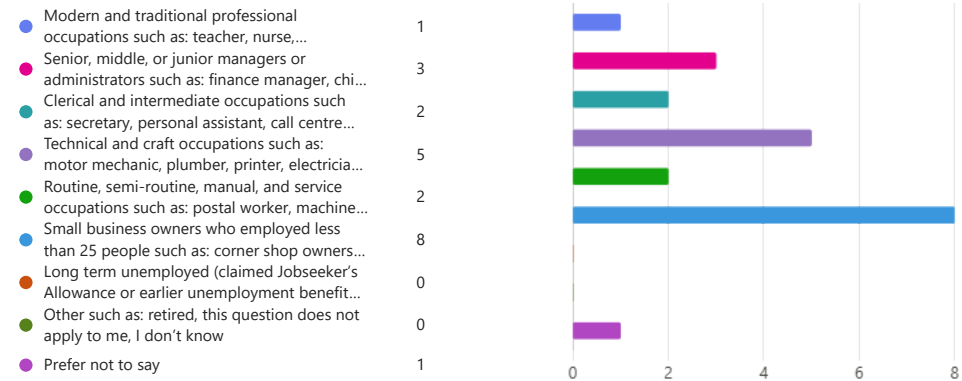

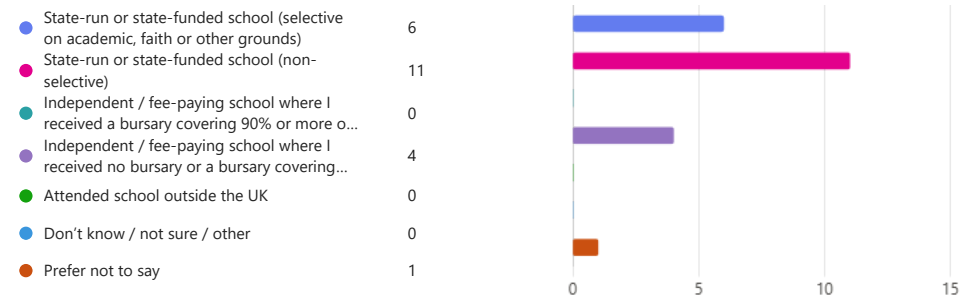


10. What was the occupation of your main household earner when you were aged about 14?



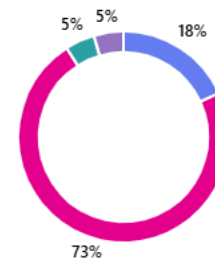

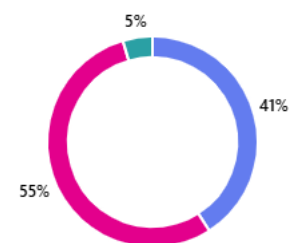
